This beautiful Saint-Emilion expresses the power and classic character of the 2014 vintage. Its perfect maturity of tannins give the wine a long finish that is fresh and aromatic. The deep, almost black color expresses the wine's youth, which calls out for decanting two hours before tasting. The wine will become more open while still maintaining a reserved aspect, showing a meaty, rich and fruity character which is the expression of its terroir. It already goes well with a leg of lamb which nicely brings out the wine's rich nature, but will be better still in five years...or even ten.
