Grand Corbin was purchased in 2011, after its 2010 harvest was vinified by the former owners. After finishing its malolactic fermentation, the wine was taken over by the new proprietors with the expert counsel of Hubert De Bouard, who has advised the Groupe SMABTP's Right Bank vineyards since 2007. A happy surprise is that the wine shows an undeniable quality. It has developed fruity aromas of black currant and blackberry, with a fleshy structure and "sunshine" in the mouth, distinguished by its finesse and elegance.
